

COLLEGE AREA SCOUTING AND EVALUATION COURSE only offered once per year (June – Dec)

Logistics:

The 1st Tuesday of each month, we will host a live webinar and install the curriculum for that month.

During the month, you will have 1 experiential learning assignment to complete. They will vary from research you can do in your home to visiting training camps or day trips college programs

The last Tuesday of each month, we will host a live webinar to review the assignment and your experiences with it and provide feedback, answer questions, and talk strategy.

- 1) This course is not film study intensive You are asked to write 2 reports
- 2) This course is not travel intensive You are asked to make a couple day trips (if possible with your schedule) trip to an NFL camp and 1 day trip to a college are ideal and can help you improve and prepare yourself for the next step in your NFL future.
- 3) We have had a people working for the Calgary Stampeders of the CFL and North Carolina State football taking the Area Scouting course.
- 4) The goal is to leave theory and put your skills into practice in small experiential learning opportunities. The assignments in this course are not mandatory.
- 5) The lectures are taped and can be viewed at anytime.
- 6) With the film evaluation course, we asked for 10-20 hours per week. This course you may put in 10-20 hours in an entire month.
- 7) Other than the live class sessions (one early and one late in the month), the rest of your time spent on the class is 100% up to you.
